WHAT IS INSPIRE?

INSPIRE is a 5-day Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander teen cultural enrichment and educational experience held in July 2026 in Southern Nevada.

INSPIRE is a teen cultural summit for Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders that is a transformative and empowering gathering that celebrates the rich heritage, traditions, and identities of these vibrant communities. It is an immersive and inclusive gathering designed to foster a deep appreciation for the diverse cultures that make up our beautiful island communities. The event provides a platform for young individuals to come together, connect, and learn about their shared cultural roots while embracing their unique backgrounds.



INSPIRE will introduce teens to:

CULTURAL WORKSHOPS: In-depth sessions covering language, history, and traditions of Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders

ART AND CRAFT DEMONSTRATIONS: Hands-on workshops where teens can learn traditional crafts like weaving, lei making, and more.

DANCE AND MUSIC PERFORMANCES: Cultural performances and entertainment such as Hula, Tahitian, song and more.

HEALTH PROMOTION: Learning how to protect and promote positive health behaviors for themselves and their community.

TEAM-BUILDING EXERCISES: Activities that promote collaboration and camaraderie among the participants like Makahiki games.

LEADERSHIP SESSION: Engaging sessions on leadership qualities, public speaking, and community-building.

At the core of the summit lies the exploration of each participant's cultural heritage. Through workshops, presentations, and interactive activities, teens will gain insights into the history, language, health, customs, and arts of our culture. The focus is on building a strong sense of identity and pride in one's roots. The summit celebrates this by featuring workshops on traditional crafts, music, dance, and storytelling. Participants will have the opportunity to learn from instructors and performers, cultivating a deeper appreciation for our heritage.



WHAT IS INSPIRE?

The benefits of INSPIRE include:

- Strengthening cultural pride and fostering a supportive network of communities and cultures.
- Promoting cross-cultural understanding and appreciation among diverse Pacific Islander groups.
- Encouraging responsibility, awareness, and sense of belonging within their respective communities and cultures.
- Developing leadership skills and empowering young individuals to become advocates for positive change and healthy lifestyles.
- Learning introductory cultural practices and skill sets like dance, music, song, crafts and more.
- Creating lasting friendships and opportunities with like-minded teens from different islands.

INSPIRE is a transformative experience that celebrates the vibrant cultural tapestry of the Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander region. Through a combination of educational workshops, artistic expressions, community engagement, and leadership development, the summit empowers the next generation of islanders to embrace their roots, protect their heritage, promote health and lead with pride and purpose. This gathering not only enriches the lives of the participants but also contributes to the preservation and perpetuation of the unique cultural legacies of Native Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders.
